
## Plan Concept Highlights

■ Identifies improvements, access, and new connections along the existing greenways in the system.

■ Establishes nine new greenway corridors.

■ Provides new greenway routes from the outer townships to the downtown area, much like the Monon Trail provides from the north.

■ Provides east-west and north-south connectivity in the ring townships, creating more localized connections within each township.

- Provides a 64-mile circle around the city connecting Fort Harrison State Park, Eagle Creek Park, Southeastway Park, and Southwestway Park.
- Provides greenway connections to over 70 Indy Parks facilities.
- Provides regional connections to eleven trail systems beyond Marion County.
- Provides administrative and policy recommendations for future operations of the greenways.
- Establishes design standards for the overall system that address safety, accessibility, and funding eligibility requirements.
- Provides an overall network that is integrated into the other major transportation components of the city---such as the Indianapolis Bikeways and future Indy Connect rapid transit lines.
